Let Honor & Respect Reign

Upcoming holidays encourage us to honor other people—especially those who make sacrifices for us. Mother's Day and Father's Day offer reminders of God's commandment to honor our parents. Memorial Day is an opportunity to remember people who've laid down their lives for our safety and freedom.

Use those holidays as springboards for family discussions about honor, respect, and sacrifice—concepts that aren't very popular in today's society. These days, children may lack respect for adults, property, one

another, and even themselves. Part displays of respect - at home or of the blame for that falls on popular elsewhere. culture, which rarely fosters an attitude of respect. But you can build of their God-given value and worth. an atmosphere of honor and respect in your home.

Here are some tips for raising up "honor"able kids:

-Offer praise when you notice



-Honor your kids by reminding them

-Don't let disrespect slide by without correction.

-Talk to your kids in a kind tone, with grace, even when disciplining them.

-Provide opportunities for children to honor others through service and acts of kindness.
